

Work Experience at Wellington Zoo

Information for students enrolling in UNITEC's Certificate of Animal Management (CertAnMgmt) and seeking a work experience placement at Wellington Zoo as part of the course requirements.

Overview of the Programme

The qualification is a one-year distance-learning (correspondence) programme and is recognised as the minimum qualification for starting a career in the zoo industry within New Zealand.

A distance-learning programme requires students to be self-motivated and committed, and to have excellent time-management skills. The course requires students to attend at block courses (in Auckland), exams, practical assessments, to complete work experience and self-directed study and complete assignments throughout the year.

Applying for a Work Experience Placement at Wellington Zoo

Wellington Zoo offers up to 5 placements per year for students completing the CertAnMgmt. This is carried out 1 day per week over 35 weeks. (Feb- Nov)

To fill the placements, we require applicants to send in:

- a cover letter
- updated CV
- details table on the following page

The cover letter should contain responses to the following questions:

- 1. Why do you want to gain the CertAnMgmt, and what do you want to do with the qualification in the future.
- 2. What are the 5 domains of Animal Welfare?
- 3. What do you think the role of a zookeeper entails.
- 4. Why do you believe Zoos are necessary in today's society, especially in New Zealand and what role do you think we will play in the future.
- 5. Briefly list any skills or prior experience that may be relevant to completing work experience at Wellington Zoo

Applications are reviewed in late October, with a combination of Work Experience and Interviews timetabled in mid November. Based on the application, interview and trial candidates are then notified if they have been successful in securing a placement by late November.

Applications received after October 30th will not be accepted.

Successful Applicants

You will be notified if you have secured a placement by late November, where we will send notification to you and to UNITEC stating placement has been offered.

Students complete work experience one day a week, 8-5pm, every week from mid-February to November. All students must attend a 1-day orientation day prior to beginning their Work Experience, in February.
